

Como Bluff was the site of one of the first major discoveries of dinosaur remains in the world! The area received notoriety because of the immense number of bones found and their near perfect preservation.





#### **Hunting and Fishing**

Calling all hikers, campers, fishers, and hunters! The Laramie River Ranch properties are in a terrain that supports masses of wildlife for viewing or hunting and reservoirs to hook various species of fish. The property is in Unit 7 for elk hunting, a unit that is considered a top trophy bull unit. Antelope tags are easily accessible for residents for Unit 42.
